CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Public participations provided an opportunity for residents of Kirinyaga County to participate in the county budget process. They identified key sectors of Agriculture, Health, Water & Natural Resources, Education and Social sectors- Youth & Gender as their priorities. In addition funds allocation should reflect the needs of the county residents.

Submissions were made by individuals, groups of people, civil society organizations (CSOs) and other non-state actors and they all emphasized accountability and transparency during the budget implementation process. After collecting views from the community, the coordinating committee recommends the following;

1. Effective monitoring systems should be put in place so as to ensure value for the funds allocated to various projects.
2. Public officers should be put on performance contracting so that they can be able to serve the community efficiently.
3. Monitoring & Evaluation Tools based on ICT should be developed so that every resident can be able to know which projects are being implemented in the county and by whom.
4. Comprehensive Feasibility studies should be conducted before projects are implemented so as to avoid wastage of public funds.
5. More funds should be directed towards infrastructure so as to open up markets for the agricultural products.
6. Also substantial funds should be directed towards projects which can generate employment among the youth so as to reduce drug abuse and thus insecurity.
7. Other sectors which should be funded well are education, health, water and agriculture.
