THE KIRINYAGA COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2015

AN ACT of County Assembly of Kirinyaga to provide for amendment of various laws related to user charges, fees, taxes for 2016 and for connected purposes.

ENACTED by County Assembly of Kirinyaga, as follows—

PART I—PRELIMINARY

Short title and commencement. 1. This Act may be cited as the Kirinyaga County Finance Act, 2015 and shall come into operation not later than 1st January 2016.

2. (1) In this Bill, unless the context otherwise requires

“County” means County Government of Kirinyaga

Interpretation “authorized channel” means making payment to the County through an officer appointed by the County to collect revenue or through any other mode of payment including but not limited to an automated revenue collection system or County Government of Kirinyaga Revenue collection agent (s)

For Business Permits and Liquor License:

“Major urban Towns “mean Kerugoya, Sagana, Wang’uru, Kagio and kutus townships.

“Medium town centers” mean Kandongu Kagumo, Kianyaga, Mutithi, Kimbimbi, Makutano, Karumandi, Baricho, Thiba and kibingoti.

“Other centers” mean the rest of shopping centers in the county.

“Cess” means fees charged for goods being exported out of the county.

PART II— FEES AND TAXES PAYABLE AND RATES APPLICABLE

Imposition, revision of the taxes, fees, etc of the County. 3. (1) The taxes, fees and charges set out in the Third, Fourth and Fifth column of all the Schedules shall apply for the respective services and at the rates set out therein.

(2) The respective taxes, fees and charges, together with the rates applicable shall take effect in not later than the month of January 2016.

(3) For greater certainty, the taxes, fees and charges applicable at the commencement of this Act shall continue to apply under the existing by-laws of the defunct Councils of Kirinyaga until such by-laws are repealed and replaced by county legislation.

Directions, 4. All directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations on financial management, including the collection and administration of taxes, fees and charges given or issued by

the defunct Councils and subsisting or valid immediately before the cessation of the application of the Local Government Act (now repealed) shall be deemed to have been given, issued or made pursuant to this Act, until the expiry, amendment or repeal of those directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations on financial management and shall continue, with the necessary modifications, apply to the payment and the administration of the taxes, fees and other levies under this Act.

5. The County Executive Committee member for finance may waive a county tax, fee or charge imposed by the county government and its entities in accordance with criteria prescribed in regulations provided that—

(a) the County Treasury shall maintain a public record of each waiver together with the reason for the waiver and report on each

(b) a State Officer may not be excluded from payment of a tax, fee or charge by reason of the office of the State Officer or the nature of work of the State Officer; and

(c) such waiver or variation has been authorised by an Act of Parliament or county legislation.

Payment

6. (1) Any payment to the County shall be paid through an authorized channel.

(2) An officer or entity appointed by the County to collect revenue shall have identification card issued by the County.

(3) A County Official receipt shall be issued for all payments made to the County.

(4) A person shall not receive or collect any money on behalf of the County unless he has been appointed to do so or has been authorized as the receiver and collector of the County revenue

(5) A person who contravenes the provisions of this section commits an offence.

General
penalty

7. Any person who commits an offence under this Act for which no penalty is provided shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding two hundred thousand shillings or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or to both, and be forced to refund the illegal gains.

8. If a staff of the County or any other person having duty to perform under this Act –

- (a) makes , in any record, or document which they are required to keep or make , an entry which they know or have reasonable cause to believe to be false or do not believe to be true;
- (b) willfully refuses to do anything which they know or have reasonable cause to know is required to be done by them;
- (c) interferes with any other person or process under this Act, so as to defeat the provisions or requirements of this Act:
- (d) where required under this Act to do anything to give effect to the provisions of this Act, fails to do such things;
- (e) without reasonable cause does omit or omits to do something in breach of his/her duty under this Act;
- (f) willfully contravene the provision of this Act to give undue advantage or favour to another person;
- (g) fails to prevent or report to the County or any other relevant authority, the commission of an offence committed under this Act,

commits an offence and is liable on conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred thousand shillings or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, or to both, and be forced to refund the illegal gains.

Parking Areas

Parking fees and Penalties A person who utilizes parking spaces within the below prescribed parking spaces shall be charged a fee specified in Part 2.3 of this bill. Any defaulter shall also be liable to penalties as indicated in this Act.

There shall be penalties for late payment of parking fees, impounding of vehicles or withdrawal of court bond as specified in part 2.3

Marking of Parking Areas The CEC Member in charge of Transport and Public works shall be responsible for marking out all parking spaces as gazetted.

Below are the gazetted areas that will attract parking charges

KERUGOYA	Areas covered by Kerugoya- Kagumo road, from Baricho road junction to Kerugoya Stadium, All parking areas within the Kerugoya town CBD, Areas within the markets, the stadium, The loop along former municipal offices, County Commissioner's and Kerugoya High Court.
WANG'URU	Areas covered by Makutano – Embu highway from River Thiba upto Nice City, All the Eastern and Western parts bordering the rice paddies.
SAGANA	Areas covered by the Nairobi – Nyeri highway from Sagana County Club to Sagana Mosque, Sagana-Kagio road to Sagana Technical, from Sagana – Murang'a road Junction to River Sagana, All of the Sagana town CBD.
KAGIO	Areas covered by Sagana – Kutus road from Club Buffalo up to Kagio open air vegetable market, Kagio- Baricho road upto the Catholic Church, Kagio – Kandongu road upto the Kagio Mosque, All of Kagio CBD.
KUTUS	Areas covered by Kutus – Kerugoya road Junction upto Thiba Millers, all of Kutus Old town, Kutus market road, Kibera Joint, County Headquarters to Livestock market access road
KAGUMO	Areas covered by Kerugoya – Karatina road and within Kagumo town CBD
KIANYAGA	Along all the road reserves within the town, around the market and all other areas within Kianyaga CBD
KIBINGOTI	Along Sagana – Karatina road and within the town
KARIA	All of Karia town CBD
MUTITHI	Areas covered by the Nairobi – Meru Highway along the town, All of Kagio CBD.
V.I.	Areas covered by Makutano –Embu Highway and within the town CBD.
P.I.	Areas covered by Makutano –Embu Highway and within the town CBD.
BARICHO	Areas covered by Kagio – Kerugoya road, Road towards Kiburu and within the town CBD.
KIMBIMBI	Areas covered by Makutano –Embu Highway, road from the highway to Kimbimbi town and within Kimbimbi town.
