

## **THE KIRINYAGA COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2016**

### **AN ACT of the County Assembly of Kirinyaga to amend the law relating to various taxes, charges and fees and for matters incidental thereto**

**ENACTED** by the County Assembly of Kirinyaga as follows-

#### **PART I-PRELIMINARY**

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| <b>1.</b> This Act may be cited as the Finance Act, 2016, and shall come into operation on the first Monday of January 2017. | Short Title and Commencement. |
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#### **PART II-BUSINESS LICENSING**

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| <b>2.</b> Section 2 of the Kirinyaga County Business Licensing Act is amended –<br><br>(a) in the definition of ‘business activity’ by;<br><br>i. deleting the words ‘carried on by a person but does not include the hawking or selling of fish, agricultural produce and local articles which are the produce of the County’ and substituting there for the words ‘includes any activity engaged in the primary purpose of making a profit’<br><br>ii. deleting the words ‘classified in a schedule provided under Section 22’ and substituting there for the words ‘categorized in the first schedule’<br><br>(b) in the definition of ‘licensing officer’ by;<br><br>i. deleting the word ‘ includes’ and substituting there for the word ‘means’; and<br><br>ii. deleting the words ‘by the county chief officer’ appearing immediately after the word designated<br><br>(c) by deleting the definition of ‘prohibited activity’ | Amendment of Section 2 of the Kirinyaga County Business Licensing Act,2014 |
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(d) by deleting the definition of ‘trade’

(e) by inserting the following definitions in the proper alphabetical order-

- i. ‘major urban areas’ means

- ii. ‘medium urban areas’ means  
Kianyaga, Mutithi, Kimbimbi, Karumandi  
Baricho, and Kibingoti urban areas
